

MAY-DAY CALL

Working Class shall Fight against Imperialism which is exploiting the Labour Power of workers of the World!

Working class shall Unitedly Fight against the Machinations of the Reactionary Religious Bigotry forces!!

For the past three decades imperialism is ruling the roost of all the countries of the entire world with its neo-liberal economic policies of capitalism. By exporting international financial capital, through transnational corporations to all the countries it is not only exploiting the labour power of the workers of those countries, but is also looting the wealth of those countries most unethically. The imperialism through the imposition of the neo-liberal capitalistic economic policies has enabled to do away with the powers of the subjected governments to restrict its policies of exploitation and loot duly undermining the sovereignty of those countries, their laws and their constitutions. It also made the concerned governments of those countries to abdicate their fundamental responsibility and duty of looking after and promoting the welfare and interests of the people of their countries.

The result of these imperialist policies is the entire wealth of the world is being amassed with 1% of the world population, while the rest of the 99% becoming poor and poorer with every passing day.

Poverty and pauperisation is ever increasing throughout the world. Unemployment is growing in to dreadful proportions. Inequalities and disparities among the people are increasing. Economic and social strife throughout the world is increasing.

The recurring economic crises and depressions are shaking the very foundations of the capitalist system and capitalism, and the capitalist system is making desperate efforts to save its skin by imposing the burden of these crises on the developing countries, by way of creating aggressive wars or by terrific looting and exploitation of wealth of the developing countries.

The imperialism has created human crises, leading to migration of millions of people to forced migrations for safety as well for finding out any means of lively-hood.

To day the workers throughout the world are agitating for dignified, safe and permanent jobs. In the developed European countries they are agitating against the anti-worker policies of 'austerity' dictated by the imperialist financial organizations W.B and IMF.

In the developing countries the workers are agitating to protect their lawful and constitutionally guaranteed rights like 'formation of an union', 'right to strike' and 'right of an 8 hours work day' which were achieved through valiant and sacrificial struggles conducted by them in the spirit of May day agitations of Chicago.

In essence the imperialism is forcing the entire humanity in to degrading living conditions without any happiness, safety or dignity, thus proving itself not at all qualified and useless to be a ruling system. The imperialist capitalism and its ruling system shall not be allowed to exist for even a single minute. This has to be totally uprooted and replaced with a world socialist system, where there will not be poverty, inequality, unemployment, disparities and which will protect the environmental balances avoiding unwarranted environmental and natural disasters.

This task will be completed successfully only by the working-class of the world. It will lead the entire oppressed people of the world, leading the world revolution in to a success. It is the historical task of the world working class destined by the history itself!

While such have been the conditions of degradation of people throughout the world, let us examine the conditions existing in our own country.

While the Modi's N.D.A. government is trumpeting its own praises by claiming that India's prestige in the world is increasing, various parameters clearly and categorically reveal that all such proclamations are totally false and misleading, and that they are purely intended to hood-wink and keep the people into false illusions about their safety, welfare and living conditions.

All the official social and economic indexes clearly pointed-out that:

- Poverty in India is growing day by day.
- Pauperization of rural India is on increase.
- Unemployment is dreadfully increasing.
- Agriculture sector which is forced in to crises has created rural disaster, leading to migration of rural masses seeking any means of lively-hood.

- e) Inequalities and disparities among the rich and poor are widening drastically.
- f) Due to casualisation, contractualisation of jobs, more than 90% of the workers in India are forced to work in the conditions of unsafe, undignified bonded labour system, in a neo-slavery, without any right or entitlements.
- g) Dalits, girijs and women are the worst affected among the toiling masses, who are often subjected to inhuman atrocities and attacks.
- h) Basic amenities like education, health services are not within the reach of the common man.
- i) With the ever increasing prices of commodities, vegetables and staple foods, common men and toiling masses are unable to acquire and find food at all within their reach.
- j) People in India are the unhappiest people even when compared with the people of Sri Lanka, Pakistan and Bangladesh.
- k) Corruption and crony capitalism have increased in abnormal promotions in India.

With the amendment of labour laws and laws of land rights the entire India has been subjected to the exploitation and loot of transnational capital without any restriction or recourse.

The independence and sovereignty of India are reduced in to mere sloganizing phrases having no meaning at all!

These are the fundamental issues and problems that have to be tackled immediately at any cost. This can be done only with struggles of the people against the governments and their anti-people and anti-working class policies.

For achieving a positive solution to the above mentioned fundamental problems faced by the toiling masses and oppressed masses the working class of India has to strive with all its efforts and force. It shall unite all the middle class and poor farmers and organize them in to struggles. The entire oppressed sections of the people along with the entire sections of toiling masses shall be mobilized and organized in to these struggles. It is the immediate historical task of working class in India to lead these united struggles in to success as has been destined by the history.

But the exploiting ruling classes of India and their representative governments in centre and in the states are doing their best to divert the attention of the workers, toiling masses and oppressed people from the fundamental issues and problems faced by them, by creating pseudo-sentimental issues of communalism religious bigotry and patriotic-chauvinism, by raising irrelevant and unwarranted slogans such as: construction of Ram temple on the site of destroyed Babri Masjid, protection of the holy cow, to chant the slogan Bharat-Maata-ki-Jai to prove ones patriotism and by conducting religious fascist type of programs against the people of minority religious beliefs and practices.

With such anti-people and anti-national slogans and activities the majority-religious bigotry and communal forces in India are creating hatred, intolerance and animosity among common people and toiling masses successfully in diverting their main attention against the fundamental problems and basic issues faced by them and the causes behind them and the means of a solution to the problems and issues.

There are some instances that even the workers, belonging to the most rational and radical class of the society are falling prey to the machinations of the communal and religious bigotry forces and pseudo-patriotic nationalistic forces; diverting from their class outlook and tasks to be taken up by them.

Thus in our country besides the imperialism, the reactionary ruling class, abetted communal, religious bigotry and pseudo-patriotic-nationalist forces have become the avowed foes of the working class, the toiling masses and the oppressed people of our country, who shall be fought tooth and nail.

Under these gloomy conditions of human epoch; CLASS STRUGGLE calls on the workers, toiling masses and the oppressed people to fight unitedly against imperialism its financial capital and its looting of wealth, and also against the anti-worker policies of our rulers that intensify exploitation of labour power. We shall demand for the reopening of the agri-based industries, small and middle class industries, P.S.U.S and private sector industries which have been closed. We shall steadily fight against the policies of the rulers that divide people and toiling masses in the name of religion, caste and region to exploit the labour power of toiling people!
