Commemoration Meeting in Progress

Forty years have passed since Com.TN left us. This is also his birth centenary year and also of Com. Devulapalli Venkateswara Rao and many other veteran communist leaders. With the aim of commemorating the life and activities- full of sacrifice and struggle for the sake of people, of these communist leaders, the district committees of Guntur and Krishna of CPI(ML) organised Com. TN's 40th death anniversary meeting at Vijayawada on 28 July 2016.

The meetings began after Com.P.Jaswantha Rao paid floral tribute to Com.TN followed by 2 minute silence observed in memory of departed communist leaders. In the meeting comrades P.Jaswantha Rao, G.Vijaya Kumar, K.Kotaiah and S.Jhansi of CPI(ML) as well as Ch.Satyanarayana, Secretary TNMemorial Committee, and B.Gurava Reddy of TNMemorial Trust spoke. The meeting was presided by Com.Y.Soni and U.Nageswara Rao.

The ruling classes are claiming that the New economic policies have been successfully implemented for 25 years and India became a world power. But the process of so-called reforms to transform Indian economy has began 1981 when India took loan from IMF and from then on the entire saga is that of prostration before the imperialist powers by the Indian ruling classes. When Com.TN wrote "India Mortgaged", the growth rates in agriculture were less than 2 percent. The same is the case after four and a half decades. The industrial growth also stagnated. The public investment in the total investment in industrial sector remained around 60% even after giving high priority to promote foreign private capital. The story of stressed assests of Public sector banks once again proved that the Indian bourgeoisie is bureacratic in nature. Though the flood gates were opened for the entry of FDIs into India, it was only a trickle. On the other, Indian financial resources arre being drained in the disguise of interest, royalties, technical fees, profits and so on. The imperialist capital is strangulating the economy and fleecing its life blood to quench the thirst for profits.

Most of the ginning mills in Guntur are facing the threat of closure as more than 60 percent of cotton crop was held by 5 MNCs buying via Cotton Corporation of India. The analysis of Com.TN proved relevant even today and it should be taken as a guide to activities.

Com.TN is communist leader. He stood by the side of people to protect their rights and attacks from the ruling classes.
