

Red Salutes to Comrade Muthireddy Sriramulu

The senior most member of the CPI (ML) Comrade Muthireddy Sriramulu passed away on 20 January 2017 due to prolonged ill health. He was 95 years old. The Andhra Pradesh State Committee of CPI (ML) expresses its heartfelt condolences to his bereaved family members.

Born in middle class peasant family in Repalle Taluq of Guntur district, Comrade Sriramulu worked as a teacher in a village school. Later inspired by the Marxist ideology, he resigned to the job and joined the Communist Party as a whole timer. He worked among the peasant masses and became one of the well known peasant leaders of Repalle taluq.



During the upheaval in the Indian communist movement, his firm conviction in Marxism-Leninism led him to CPI(M) and later the communist revolutionary camp led by Com.TN and DV. He was jailed several times during his political life. Contesting on behalf of the Communist Party, he was elected twice as the sarpanch of his village and also neighbouring village.

After the withdrawal of Emergency in 1977, he paid much attention to the democratic rights movement. Later he returned to his original field of work and became a member of state executive committee of Ryatu Cooli Sangham.

During the last two decades, even at the ripe age, he stood by the side of struggling peasants for lands in Palnadu area of Guntur district. In his death the peasant movement in Guntur district lost a staunch supporter and an experienced leader.

The Andhra Pradesh State Committee pays revolutionary homage to the departed leader Comrade Muthireddy Sriramulu. We will always remember him for the love and humility he has shown even towards very young comrades.
