**“We will always remember Com TN as a
Beacon Light”**



Tarimela Nagireddy Memorial Trust organized a public meeting at Nandyal town, Kurnool district on 20 November 2016 on the occasion of his centenary birth year. The meeting was presided over by Com. B.Suryanarayana Reddy, Chairman of the TNM Trust.
