

REVOLUTIONARY HOMAGE

Comrade Kasturi Kutumba Rao, Age 63 years. A leader of AIFTU(N) in Prakasham District, AP, died of heart failure on Dec 20, 2017. In his life, he was active as a worker and the leader of trade Union. He organised the transport, handloom, beedi and other workers on their rights and problems and participated in a number of protest movements of the people.

Comrade Pintu Biswas, Age 60 years. He died of ill health on Dec 25, 2017. He was a Member of Sub Committee, All Bengal Tea Gardens Trade Union, Darjeeling district, West Bengal. He devoted best of his energies in organising the workers.

Comrade Venkata Kotaiah, Age 93 years. A Communist of first generation of Indian Communist Movement. He was a leader of CPI (ML) and working class in Guntur district. He died of failing health in his house in Tenali of Guntur district in AP on Dec 29, 2017. Working as a labourer in timber depots, he organised timber workers and cart pullers into unions and struggles on their problems.

Comrade Yeddanapudi Soni, Age 60 years. For long, he was suffering from serious heart ailments and died in a hospital in Vijayawada (AP) on Feb 19, 2018. He shouldered the responsibility of Party organisation in Krishna district of AP.

He was the State Secretary of APFTU in 2008 and later, the AP State Secretary of AIFTU(N). He also worked as the Treasurer and the Asst. Secretary of RCS (AP). Despite poor health, he had gone to different districts to directly take part and help the Comrades in leading the movements of workers, peasants and adivasis in AP.
