

Red Salutes to Comrade Bandru Narsimhulu

Com. Bandru Narsimhulu was a veteran communist revolutionary leader and determined fighter for the cause of oppressed people as a senior leader of CPI (ML) Janasakthi. He breathed his last on 22nd January, 2022 at the ripe age of 104 years at Hyderabad.



At the time of his death he was the Editor of 'Praja Vimochana' a fortnightly organ of CPI(ML)-Janasakthi.

He entered his active political life at the time of Bongiri conference of Andhra Maha Sabha known as 'Sangam', in 1944. From the beginning he was active among people, issues and their struggles under the banner of Andhra Maha Sabha and then Communist Party.

Com. Bandru took part in Telengana Armed Struggle, and undergone severe repression and jail life in those days. In all junctures of ideological struggles he stood firmly with the revolutionary politics. He left CPI, and join CPI(M) and later after Naxalbari peasants struggle worked under the leadership of Comrades TN, DV, CP, KV. Ever since he continued with revolutionary politics. In 1969 December the AP government foisted a conspiracy case against 68 communist revolutionaries known as Hyderabad-TN, DV conspiracy case. Comrade Bandru was one of the accused along with TN, DV and other comrades from various districts and convicted. His commitment and valuable experiences in the communist movement of eight decades of political life gives us a great inspiration, particularly to younger generations. Our revolutionary red salutes to Com Bandru Narsimhulu.
