

Foundation Stone of Memorial of Martyrs Nilambar and Pitambar Laid

On November 15th, 2022, a team of Shaheed Nilambar–Pitambar Samaroh Samiti reached Nilambar–Pitambarpur and laid the foundation stone of the Memorial (Samadhi Sthal). On November 14th, a two–day march started from Chemo Senya, the native village of Martyrs Nilambar and Pitambar and went to Nilambar–Pitambarpur, the place of their martyrdom. Along the way, the birth anniversary of Martyr Birsa Munda was celebrated at Ramkanda, Daltonganj and a strong resistance was registered against the Company Raj by burning copies of the Forest Conservation Amendment Act proposed by the Central Government.

After reaching Nilambar–Pitambarpur (Lesliganj), the foundation stone for the construction of the Memorial was laid by Devnarayan Singh, the great grandson of the Martyrs. Afterwards a street meeting was held at Gandhi Chowk. Speakers at the meeting said that the Government wants to wipe off the memories of the martyrdom of the Martyrs and end their struggle. The comrades of Nilambar–Pitambar Shahadat Samaroh Samiti resolved to establish the glorious history of the Martyrs as well as to take their struggles forward and realise their dreams. The comrades of the Shahadat Samaroh Samiti said that there will be no dictatorial rule in the country of Nilambar, Pitambar and Birsa Munda. Along with the foundation stone of the Memorial in Nilambar Pitambarpur, there will be a village-to-village march in the entire Palamu division on the issue of Water–Forest–Land and on March 28th, 2023, on the occasion of the martyrdom day of Nilambar–Pitambar, a huge public meeting will be held in Nilambar–Pitambarpur (Lesliganj).

The meeting at Gandhi Chowk was presided over by CPI(ML) leader Kamlesh Singh Chero.
