
Revolutionary Tributes to Comrade Ranjit Singh, Central Committee Member, CPI (ML)

He has been running the Hindi magazine 'Bhagat Singh Ka Sapne' for many years. He led many movements centred around the district of Jhunjhunu, Rajasthan. He has written many books and made many translations. For the past ten years,he has made major contributions to Tarimela Nagireddy Memorial Trust Hindi publications to bring essential literature to North India.Comrade Ranjit worked tirelessly to translate into Hindi the books, 'India Mortgaged', and the huge 'Historical and Polemical documents of the Communist Movement in India' published by the Trust in two volumes. Even when his spouse was in bed with cancer, he sat next to her and did translations for months. No communist worker can ever forget his committed efforts for a better tomorrow for the working class.
