

# A Blow of Disqualification on Rahul Gandhi

The extreme step taken on Rahul Gandhi is the climax of deep crisis that the ruling classes are facing. Prohibiting him from competing in parliament or assembly elections for eight years is the most undemocratic act.

Fascism means subordination to foreign finance capital. Fascism is the rule of the most reactionary, most fierce section of finance capital, which in countries like India is subjugation to worst section of foreign finance capital. Its goal is to have hegemony and aggression on border countries. It provokes the people by dividing them on the basis of race, region, religion and caste. It deceives the people with cooperative schemes and welfare measures. It takes revenge on those who hinder its goal by tyranny, violence and murders. It arrests and puts behind the bars all progressive forces, revolutionaries and the people who participate in mass movements.

This is the definition of fascism from Marxist angle.

At present the BJP government is very aggressive in establishing a Hindu regime. It follows the Hindu traditional oppressive theory. It wants to practise actively the most tyrannical Manu 'adharma' theory of inequalities. It creates a situation in which our country subordinates to imperialist finance capital. It supports one section of big bourgeois section and serves it.

It is playing mockery with the military, legal, economic, cultural etc. systems by incapacitating their limited independence also.

The decision of disqualification on Rahul is a clear example to show how it is not in a position to tolerate the people of its own class. The real reason for this disqualification is not for exposing Modi sarcastically or for criticising Ambani and Adani. The crisis created by exploiting ruling classes in the Indian economic, political, cultural system resulted now as a deep rivalry between two ruling parties. It is a crisis which cannot be resolved.

Keeping in mind all these facts we have to question the punishment given by a lower court of Surat on Rahul Gandhi who is representing the Wayanad parliamentary constituency. We have to condemn this conspiracy of BJP.

The policy of the bourgeois ruling parties is to create hegemony to imperialists and its capital in our country. Whichever party comes into power tomorrow, will practise only tyranny and despotism. The fascist blow today is on the leader of the Congress party and

tomorrow the blow may fall on anyone. We experienced in the past tyrannical trends. The tyranny today is in the shape of fascism and fascist danger is looming large before us.

The Indian society is in a crisis by losing its progressive spirit because of the hegemony of ruling classes and their rule. Our people are experiencing this for a very long time. This has brought endless suffering and sorrow to our oppressed people. The society as a whole is in the clutches of a stupor. The ruling class is not in a position to tolerate even bourgeois opposition and so is resorting to serious fascist acts and policies.

In accordance to this policy the present BJP rulers are trying to establish their hegemony firmly in the political arena, by oppressing the opposition parties and by dismantling or cajoling the state governments of the opposition parties.

In this situation, particularly when the tyranny in the shape of fascism danger is looming large before us, it is the bounden duty of the communist revolutionaries to increase the class consciousness among people and mobilise the toiling people (workers and peasants) and downtrodden of rural and urban areas in to mass organisations and class struggles to fight against the rule of exploiting class.
