## All India Revolutionary Students Convention: Held Successfully

The All India Revolutionary Students' Convention was successfully held at Jantar Mantar, New Delhi on October 8 under the auspices of AIPSF, PDSF, PDSO, PDSU, AIRSO, PACHHAS, COLLECTIVE, ISU, PDYF, PSU and other 5 revolutionary student organisations with 500 delegates from 15 states.

Convention demanded cancellation the National Education Policy - 2020, providing education, permanent and dignified employment to all, reject the public private partnership, foreign collaboration and self-financing models of education, protest against the introduction of NTA as well as examinations like CUET, NEET etc., resist the ruling class's agenda of exclusion of students through different entrance examinations, protest against the stoppage and reduction of various scholarships, protest against the rampant fee-hike in educational institutions, reject the financial autonomy/ 'Graded Autonomy' model of handing over the state's responsibility of funding educational institutions to the private, oppose the caste and gender based discrimination and atrocities in educational institutions, fight for a scientific, rational, free and compulsory education for all in one's mother tongue, resist the policy of language imposition, unite against the policies of privatization and commercialisation of education, pursued by the ruling class, reverse all decisions to close/ merge state-funded schools or outsource/lease/sell/auction them to corporate houses, religious bodies and NGOs, resist the chauvinist, communal, patriarchal, hyper nationalist, brahmanical hindutva ideology of RSS-BJP, fight for the right to form student unions and for ensuring the right to debate and dissent in every educational institution, fight against the fascist attacks on educational institutions and the students, resist saffronisation of education, protest against the unscientific alterations in the syllabus to implement the agenda of the fascist forces.
