

Working Class should Differentiate between Trade Union Activities and Revolutionary Political Activities

All India workers front organizers plenum was organised on Feb 24th and 25th, 2024. The political and organisational problems faced by the working class movement and the emergence of working class as a leading force for the democratic revolution were discussed in the plenum. The working class movement is immersed in reformism and economism. The plenum emphasized the transformation of the working class movement into a political force to succeed the democratic revolution. The Plenum emphasized the necessity of the workers movement to differentiate between trade union politics and revolutionary politics and the need to transform the working-class movement into a political movement.

In the present national and international situation, we must oppose the threat of imperialist aggression and exploitation and oppose the wars created for retaining their supremacy by the capitalist forces of the world. The people are suffering in the ongoing bloodbath in Israel and Palestine war. Plenum expresses its solidarity with the Palestinian peoples' struggle. It condemned the imposition of four labour codes and resolves to wage a relentless struggle for its withdrawal. It expressed its solidarity and support to the peasant struggle of Punjab, Haryana and western UP demanding MSP for their produce.

The plenum emphasized that there is a need for the working class to fight against the BJP government's Hindutva politics and conservative politics and against the comprador, bourgeoisie and bureaucracy's exploitative policies in India.
