

CPI(ML) Election Campaign in Tamil Nadu

The election campaign was carried out for the first phase of the parliamentary elections on 19-04-2024 exposing the communal BJP and its allies and their anti-people policies and for establishing peoples' democracy. Com G. Radha in Chidambaram constituency and Com V. Ayyappan in Kanyakumari constituency were fielded as candidates from CPI(ML) Tamil Nadu. In Chidambaram constituency, campaign meetings were held in important towns including Chidambaram, Sethiathoppu, Andimadam, Maruthur, Jayankondam, and Thoppur. The campaign was carried on for four days in various rural areas in an auto rickshaw with a loudspeaker. Around 15 comrades were involved in this campaign for 10 days and thousands of pamphlets were distributed.

The campaign was well received among the workers, peasants and democratic forces. It was received positively among the bourgeoisie also due to their contradictions in the ruling class camp. However, due to financial constraints, the 15-days available for the elections campaign were not fully utilised. But a heated political debate was opened among the people with the campaign.
